Audience routes for public and Task Force review

Proposal material for review. Not filed legislation. Review by counsel, fiscal, agency, accessibility, privacy, clinical, Medicaid, transit, procurement, and community reviewers is required before filing or implementation.

Reviewer paths

This guide helps each audience start with the parts of the Act most relevant to their role while still preserving one shared review process.

Audience	Start here / Review focus
Public readers	Read the purpose, what ANCHOR is, and what ANCHOR is not. Comment on clarity and accessibility.
Parents and caregivers	Review PASSport, Academy training, crisis prevention, Mobile NAV, and caregiver support. Comment on practical use.
Autistic and neurodivergent adults	Review adult access, non-phone options, communication choice, consent, burnout support, AAC, and privacy.
Professionals and providers	Review training, referral boundaries, clinical limits, documentation, safe handoffs, and Mobile NAV roles.
Schools, responders, public workers	Review calm response, communication access, SRO/public-safety training, incident context, and handoff procedures.
Task Force and policymakers	Review governance, statewide need, fiscal posture, reporting, agency coordination, and implementation phases.
Legal/fiscal/privacy reviewers	Mark statutory, appropriation, data, Medicaid, procurement, transit, accessibility, and counsel issues before filing.
Partners and community sites	Review participation pathways, Access Atlas, business certification, parks, libraries, transit, and community anchor sites.

Four-step review

1. Read the Act orientation. 2. Inspect sections by topic. 3. Comment by section and audience. 4. Download or print the review packet needed for discussion.
